Dear Residents, Families and Friends,

As we experience colder weather and move into the Holiday Season our team has been focused on establishing guidelines that will ensure the continued safety and well-being of the residents: physically, spiritually, socially and psychologically.

Before I share the new initiatives with you, I want to acknowledge how difficult the past 9 months have been for you as well. I thank you for understanding that the initiatives that are being and have been implemented are for the “highest good” of your loved ones, yourselves, and our staff. We remain Covid-19 free since August 13, 2020. I ask you to continue to support the initiatives and encourage your loved ones to do so. Thank you for being part of the team.

On November 16, we re-opened the Dining Room while maintaining the cohorts. Social distancing, plexiglass dividers at all tables while dining, and split seating sessions continue. We continue to follow recommendations from CDC, Department of Health, and OSHA.

The Country Kitchen has now been dedicated as an activity/ recreation area as our programs are expanding.

## **Indoor Visitation**

We are offering **indoor visiting** hours starting on **Wednesday November 18, 2020**. Visits will be 7 days a week, on the half hour, from 10:00am-12:00pm and 1:00pm-2:30pm.

Visitors are still required to undergo COVID-19 screening and have their temperature checked at the Lobby Kiosk prior to visitation. The receptionist will provide directions to the visit location after the screening and sign in process has been completed.

**Visitors will now be required to wear an N95 mask for all inside visitation. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you upon arrival.**

Visits will be limited to two per week for us to be considerate of all our residents/family members who would like to participate in our indoor visitation program. You are welcome to call each day to inquire as to whether there is an open visit slot.

**Outdoor Visitation** - One slot will continue to be available for **outside visitation**.

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## **Visitors are still required to undergo COVID-19 screening at the kiosk upon arrival.**

- Visitors will now be required to wear an N95 mask for all **inside** visitation. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you upon arrival.
- Social distancing (minimum of 6 feet) **must always be maintained.**
- No physical contact between residents and individuals is permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, hugging, kissing, hand holding and all other forms of physical contact.
- Any visitor diagnosed with COVID-19, under investigation for COVID 19, with a temperature above 99.4 degrees Fahrenheit, with chills, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, sore throat, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, or who traveled from a designated COVID\_19 “hot spot” within the past 14 days will not be permitted to visit.
- We strongly urge you not to share food/drink. Visitor may bring items for the resident but must leave the package with reception. Visitors may bring their own drinks but may not share them with the resident. Hydration will be provided for the residents by the facility.
- Visitors/individuals will not be permitted into the building beyond the reception area and **restrooms will not be available to visitors.**

## **VISITING**

A resident who is suspected or confirmed to be infected with COVID-19; or quarantined for a COVID-19 exposure cannot have visitors.

A resident who has been diagnosed with COVID-19/tested positive is allowed visitation only after they have met the criteria for discontinuation of isolation after 14 days per facility policy.

A resident who is on isolation because, within the past 14 days, they were either admitted/re-admitted, leave the facility for any non-medical reason including any home visits or holiday family outing/gathering from **(November 25 – December 31, 2020)**, or were exposed to a COVID-19 positive employee, is allowed visitation only after they have met the criteria for discontinuation of isolation after **14 days per facility policy.**
